Know all men by these presents that I Holland Allbe of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Yeoman, in consideration of eleven hundred dollars paid by Thomas Carey of said Mendon Yeoman, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do give grant sell and convey unto the said Thomas Carey his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land situated in said Mendon upon Misquoc Hill (so called) upon the Southerly side of the road leading from Charles A. Davenport's to Perley Taft's in Upton and bounded as follows viz: Beginning at the Northeasterly corner of said tract and the Northwesterly corner of the orchard of grantor at a corner of wall: thence Southerly and bounded Easterly by other land of grantor being the orchard aforesaid until it comes to the land improved by Charles A. Davenport: thence continuing Southerly and bounded Easterly by land improved by said Charles A. Davenport until it comes to land of George Wood: thence continuing Southerly and bounded Easterly by land of George Wood until it comes to a corner of wall and fence, as the wall and fence now stands: thence turning and running Westerly and bounded Southerly by land of said George Wood as the wall and fence now stands to a corner at other land of grantor called the Pond Hole pasture: thence turning and running Northerly and bounded Westerly by said Pond Hole pasture until it comes to the end of the wall: thence turning and running Westerly and bounded Southerly by said Pond Hole pasture about two rods to near the Southerly end of a wall at land of Nathan George: thence turning and running Northerly and bounded Westerly by the land of Nathan George and land of John Kegan to a corner at other land of grantor: thence turning and running Easterly as the wall now stands crossing by the Northerly end of a wall running Southerly to a corner: thence turning and running Northerly as the wall now stands to the afore mentioned road: thence turning and running Easterly by and with the road afore mentioned to the first mentioned bound at the orchard aforesaid together with all the buildings standing thereon and all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging save and except that the grantor reserves the licker mill building with the right to remove the same at any time within
