

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

that I, Julius A. George, of Mendon, in the County of Worcester, and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the mortgagee named in two certain mortgages given by Myra C. Allen, wife of Charles H. Allen to me, respectively dated November 19th, A. D. 1902, July 28th, A. D. 1903, A. D. 18 and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Libro\_ 1735, 1755, Folio\_ 51, 532, in consideration of --A Dollars paid by said Myra C. Allen, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby **R E M I S E, R E L E A S E** and forever **Q U I T C L A I M** unto the said Myra C. Allen, all the right, title and interest which I acquired under the aforesaid mortgage\_ in or to that portion of the premises therein conveyed, which is described as follows, namely: Beginning at a stone bound set in the ground in the westerly line of Main Street in said MENDON, and at the northeasterly corner of land of the Town of Mendon; thence S. 67° 15' W. 50 feet to a stone set in the ground, bounding southerly by said Town of Mendon land; thence S. 74° 15' W. 172.5 feet to the centre of the wall; at a stone bound, bounding southerly by other land of said Myra C. Allen; thence N. 11° 30' W. with said wall 75.5 feet to a corner of wall; bounding westerly by land of Eugene E. Brown; thence N. 65° 15' E. 154 feet to end of wall; thence N. 68° 45' E. 59.5 feet to the westerly line of said Main Street; the last two lines bounding on land of Emeline Moore; thence S. 18° 30' E. 99 feet to the point of beginning.

**T O H A V E** and **T O H O L D** the same to the said Myra C. Allen and her heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. But this release shall not in any way affect or impair my right to hold under the said mortgage\_ and as security for the sum remaining due thereon, or to sell under the power of sale in said mortgage\_ contained, all the remainder of the premises therein conveyed, and not hereby released.
