


And I the said grantor for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the afore granted premises: that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof we the said Amariah A Taft and Thankful S Taft wife of the said Amariah in token of her release of all right and title of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this sixth day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy
