Excepting from the above conveyance the pile of loam which is now stored on the above described premises and reserving to the Grantor, for a period of six months from the date hereof only, the right to enter upon the described premises from time to time for the purpose and to remove said loam from said premises.

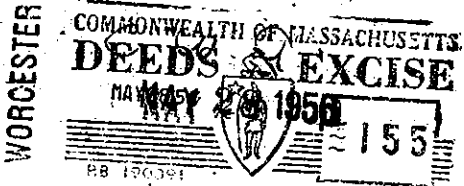
