A certain parcel of land situated on the southerly side of Hopedale Street in Mendon, Worcester County, Massachusetts, being Lot 8 as shown on plan entitled "A Plan of S. T. Davenport's Farm Mendon by D. Davenport 14th March 1847", as copied and further surveyed by Henry W. Gaskill, C. E., in June 1908, said plan being filed with Worcester District Deeds, Plan Book 13, Plan 73, and bounded and described as shown on said plan as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of the granted premises at a point in the southerly line of said Hopedale Street, said point being in the Mendon-Hopedale Town Line;

THENCE southwesterly along the southerly line of said Hopedale Street to the northeasterly corner of Lot 6 as shown on said plan;

THENCE S. 10° 30' E., 28 rods;

THENCE S. 20° 30' E., 3.5 rods to land formerly of Joseph G. Davenport, said last two lines bounding on Lot 6 as shown on said plan;
