I, Alice A. Spaulding, of Leominster, in Worcester County, Massachusetts (being unmarried) for consideration paid, grant to John T. Gorts and Edith M. Gorts (husband and wife) to hold to themselves and the survivor of them, as tenants by entirety, with all the usual rights of survivorship, and not as tenants in common, both of said grantees, being of Leominster, in Worcester County, Massachusetts, with Q U I T C L A I M covenants. The land located on the easterly shore of Lake Monomonec in the Town of WINCHESTER, in Worcester County, Massachusetts as shown on a plan of Camp Lots, filed in Plan Book 45, Page 38, of the Worcester District Registry of Deeds and being lot numbered 18, on said plan, with frontage of one hundred (100) feet on the shore line of said Lake Monomonec, and said lot running in length back to the line of the private way, as shown on said plan, with no fee however, conveyed hereby in the land situated in the said private way, but hereby including all rights of way over the ways as shown on said plan, insofar as the same belong to the said grantor, or are implied in the grant to her, to which reference is herein-after made. Hereby meaning and intending to convey to said grantees, the said lot numbered 18, on said plan, the same being in size and location as indicated on said plan, together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, and including all buildings and improvements thereon.

Hereby meaning and intending to convey the same premises that were conveyed to the grantor, by John T. Gorts, by deed dated August 16th, 1949 and to be recorded. Said premises are conveyed subject to all taxes, if any remain unpaid.

The consideration for this conveyance being not over one hundred dollars, no revenue is due the United States and no stamps are attached hereto.
